Explanation of Responses:

- On March 4, 2020, there were 3,470 deferred share units ("DSUs") that settled, and were converted into shares of common stock of Ambac Financial Group, Inc. (the "Company").
- Represents DSUs that were converted into shares of common stock and withheld by the Company to satisfy certain tax withholding obligations.
- Each DSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Company's common stock.
- Each restricted stock unit ("RSU") represents a contingent right to receive one share of the Company's common stock.
- On March 4, 2020 the reporting person received a grant of 10,897 RSUs as part of his 2020 Long Term Incentive Plan award. The RSUs will vest in three equal installments commencing January 2, 2021, January 2, 2022, and January 2, 2023.
